

Supplies for Grade 5 2009-2010

To parents of children entering Grade 5:

In addition to the classroom supplies that we will provide for your child's use at school, please have your child bring all of the following supplies next year. **All supplies should be brought to the classroom by the end of the first week of school.** They will be stored at school, ready for your child's use.

*****Please ensure that all items are clearly labeled with your child's name.**

Some of the supplies on the list can/should be purchased at the PTA Shop, and are usually cheaper than the local price. Please refer to the back of this sheet to see a list of supplies available at the shop. Should you wish to pre-order your supplies, fill in the form and deposit it into the PTA box in Reception. Your order will be ready for pick-up as of Monday, August 10, 2009.

1 large	Ziploc bag for supplies
1	French/English dictionary for home use
1	Mother Tongue to English/English to Mother Tongue Dictionary at student's level (Only for students whose mother tongue is not English – Not Available in Zambia)
	<u>Available from PTA Shop (usually cheaper than locally):</u>
2*	Erasers, large
1*	Ruler, 12"/30cm

If you choose to purchase some of your supplies overseas, please keep in mind that AIS uses A4 paper, and binders, filler paper, plastic sleeves, etc, should be A4. U.S. Letter size paper is not the same as A4.

To ensure consistency, the following items should be purchased from the PTA Shop:

2	Ringed Binder, A4 (2 rings or 4)
1	Dividers, A4, set of 10
7	Spiral notebooks, A4
5	Paper pocket folders, A4
100	Plastic Sleeves, A4
1	Sketch Book, A3
1	large plastic folder
1	Sturdy homework folder that can be fastened shut

*As these items will be kept at school, please ensure your child has access to similar supplies at home.

Calculators will be provided at school for use in class. Students should not bring personal calculators to school, as our experience has been that these are repeatedly lost.
