The Psychology department at the University of Colorado Boulder regards the science of psychology and neuroscience as ideal platforms to enhance students' critical thinking, creativity, complex reasoning, research skills, and effectiveness in written and oral communication.

The undergraduate Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology provides an excellent background for positions in administration, recreation, health education, personnel work, labor relations, advertising, public relations, vocational rehabilitation, research, further professional studies, and much more.
